## Directions to Morris County Park Commission Cultural Center in Morris Township

### From Morristown Green

Turn RIGHT onto Washington St. Travel 3.5 miles west towards Mendham and Chester on County Route 510 West (formerly Route 24) passing Delbarton School on your left. The Cultural Center entrance is located at 300 Mendham Road on the LEFT approximately 0.5 mile past Lewis Morris County Park.

### From Route 287 South

Take Exit 35, Madison Ave. Turn RIGHT and at the light turn RIGHT onto Route 124 West, South Street. Continue straight, travel around the "Green." Turn RIGHT Washington St. Continue on County Route 510 West (Formerly Route 24) passing Delbarton School on your left. The Cultural Center entrance is located at 300 Mendham Road on the LEFT, approximately 0.5 mile past Lewis Morris County Park.

### From Route 287 North

Take Exit 35, South Street/Madison Ave. Turn LEFT onto Route 124 West, South Street. Follow the directions above from South Street.

### From Mendham

Take County Route 510 East (formerly Route 24) towards Morristown. The Cultural Center entrance is located at 300 Mendham Road on the RIGHT just after entering Morris Township.
