- Be at least 13 years old
- Have some prior experience
- Be able to swim
- Be able to carry a kayak alone or with assigned partner
- Wear a flotation device at all times.

A shuttle will take us from the end point back to Melanie Lane where lunch will be provided at about 11:30 a.m.
